WALTER LIPPMANN: "It was an error to suppose that Western Europe could be united politically for the purpose of creating a European Army. The attempt to create a European Army, since it involves the rearmament of Germany, is disuniting Europe, and there has been a notable deterioration in Franco-German relations ever since the good beginning of the Schuman Plan was interrupted by our insistence on German rearmament. It is only in so far as Europe begins to feel reasonably secure against war that the complex question of unity can begin to be soluble."

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
