## Thirty-Second Division

National Guard of Michigan and Wisconsin: Arrived in France February 20, 1918. Activities:

Alsace front, May 18 to July 21; Fismes front, July 30 to August 7 (advance from the Ourco

to the Vesle); Soissons front, August 28 to

September 2 (battle of Juvigny); Argonne-Meuse offensive, September 30 to October 20 (operations against Kriemhilde Stellung); front east of the Meuse,

Dun-sur-Meuse, November 8 to 11; Army of Occupation from November 17.

Prisoners captured: 40 officers, 2,113 men. Guns captured: 21 pieces of artillery, 190 machine guns. Total advance on front line, 36 kilometers.

Insignia: Barred arrow of red, chosen because they "shot through every line the Boche put before them."
