Third Corps

Organized May 8, 1918. Commanders: Lieut. Gen. R. L. Bullard (then Major General), Maj. Gen. W. M. Wright and Maj. Gen. J. L. Hines. At time of the Meuse-Argonne offensive, September 26, 1918, the corps was composed of the 1st, 8rd, 4th, 88rd and 80th Divisions. Eighteen different divisions operated with the corps at one time and another during this offensive.

Insignia: Three pointed star, the center triangle, formed from the base lines, being in white, the points in blue.
